General Expectations

Parent Participation

The most effective religious formation happens when parents and the catechetical staff work together. We ask parents to participate with their children by accepting the following responsibilities:

- 1 Attend Mass on a regular basis with your children on Sundays and Holy Days.
- 2 Have your child attend ALL of his/her faith formation sessions.
- 3 Work on their prayers and assignments with them.
- 4 Contact the staff or your child's catechist with your concerns. Talk directly to us.
- 5 Parent meetings are held to educate you about the programs. It is essential you attend these meetings.
- 6 Attend the seasonal Family nights and monthly Masses each year.

Student Participation

Students are asked to:

- 1 Make a personal commitment to regularly attend classes and participate in their group activities and discussions.
- 2 Be responsible to bring their book and any other materials requested by their catechist. Complete assigned homework on time.
- 3 Show respect of self, others, and property at all times.
- 4 Be open to personal prayer, group prayer and parish liturgies.

Attendance Policy

Class Arrival

For safety, children will not be allowed into their classrooms until 5 minutes before class time. Please, wait in the gathering area.

Class Dismissal

Parents are asked to park their cars in approved parking spaces and to enter the building. Once the classes ends you will need to pick up your child(ren) from their classroom.
